DAY 1 KUALA LUMPUR - LJUBLJANA

(Meals On Board)

Assemble in KLIA International Airport for flight to Ljubljana, the capital and largest city of Slovenia.

DAY 2 LJUBLJANA - BLED - LJUBLJANA

(Meals On Board / Dinner)

Upon arrival, travel to Slovenia's most famous lake, **Lake Bled**. Embark on a sightseeing tour of Lake Bled. Marvel at the stunning crystal blue-green lake, immerse in its idyllic surroundings and fresh clear air, take a moment to ponder and understand why it is described by many as paradise on Earth. Delve deeper into the region's beauty with a **pletna boat ride to Bled Island**, a picturesque islet crowned by the exquisite Church of the Assumption. Next visit the **Bled Castle** and enjoy a sumptuous lunch paired with amazing views from the castle's perch atop a rocky cliff.

DAY 3 LJUBLJANA - POSTOJNA - ZAGREB

(Breakfast / Chinese Dinner)

This morning, get acquainted with the city's ancient charms with a tour through the heart of its old town. You will visit baroque-style architecture of **Church of St Nicholas** with its impressive twin bell towers and towering dome. Next, proceed to **Market Colonnade** and stroll through dozens of charming little shops selling a wide variety of souvenirs and local produce such as apples and honey. The market also curves along the east bank of the river Ljubljanica, between **Triple Bridge** and **Dragon Bridge**, offering plenty of visual treats as well. Cross Triple Bridge to the city's main meeting point, **Preseren Square**, named after the greatest Slovene poet, France Preseren. After that, continue your visit to **Postojna Cave**, one of Slovenia's most famous landmarks. The massive underground cave system with hanging and rising formations is truly beyond imagination. Then, enjoy a scenic drive to Zagreb.

DAY 4 ZAGREB - PLITVICE - ZADAR

(Breakfast / Seafood with Ozjusko Pivo Beer Dinner)

Today, you will go back in time to the Middle Ages with a stroll through the upper town to **St Mark's Church**, **Stone Gate**, and the ancient **Lotrscak Tower**. Embark on a sightseeing tour of this old Central European city, with its Baroque atmosphere in the upper town, picturesque open-air markets and great shopping. Take in sights like **Ban Jelacic Square**, **Zagreb Cathedral** and stroll around **Dolac Market** and **Ilica Street**. Next, visit one of Europe's most impressive national parks - the **Plitvice Lakes National Park**. Take pleasure in a guided tour of the beautiful landscapes within the UNESCO National Heritage Park, adorned with sixteen lakes that are interconnected by a series of waterfalls and deep woodland populated by deer, bears, wolves, boars and rare bird species. Savour the riveting beauty of nature from a different perspective on the waters as you join an Electric Boat Ride. Then continue to Zadar, a city built in the centre of the Croatian Adriatic and steeped in three thousand years of tumultuous history.

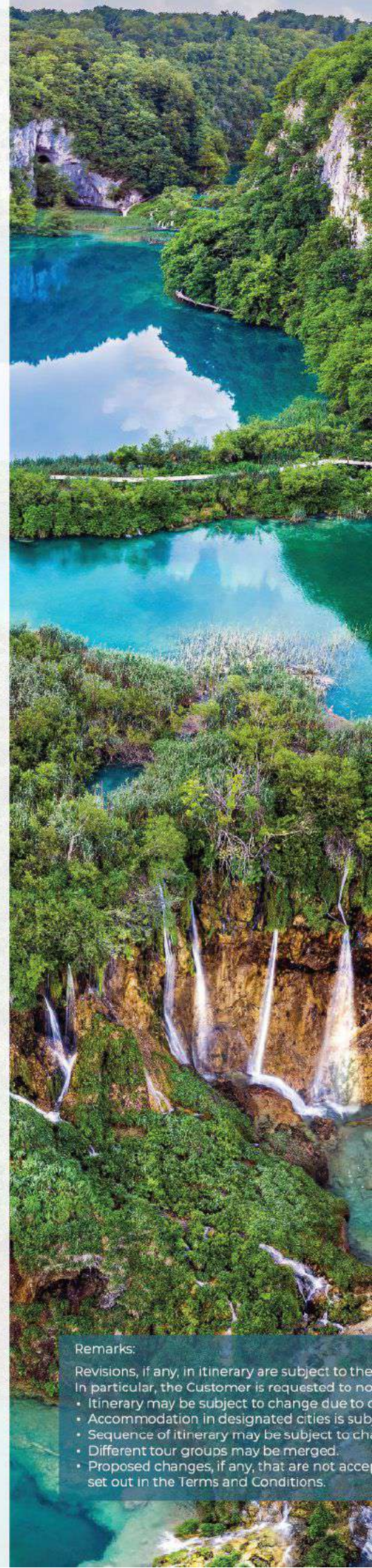

DAY 5 ZADAR - SPLIT

(Breakfast / Lunch / Dalmatian Grilled Fish Dinner)

After breakfast, embark on a city tour of Zadar. Stroll along the city's main street Katedralna and see the largest **Roman Forum** on the Adriatic Coast. Next, marvel at the magnificent designs of **Church of Saint Donatus** and the **Cathedral of St. Anastasia**, and not forgetting to listen to the city's famous **Sea Organ**. Then drive through the Croatian countryside to Split, the 2nd-largest city in Croatia. Soak up the exuberance of the Dalmatian city of Split as you embark on a city tour through its most important sights. Relive the days of the past as you come face-to-face with **Diocletian's Palace**, **Temple of Jupiter** and **Cathedral of St. Domnius**. With the dramatic coastline and turquoise waters of the Adriatic surrounding remnants of Roman, Renaissance and Gothic buildings, this charming city is a sight to behold.

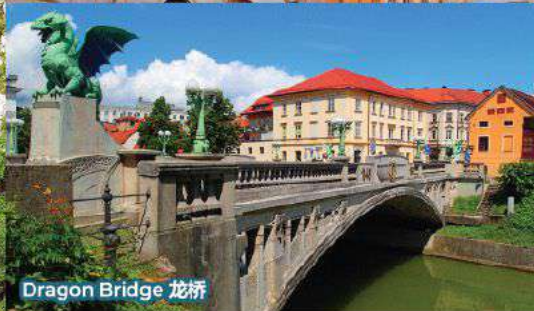

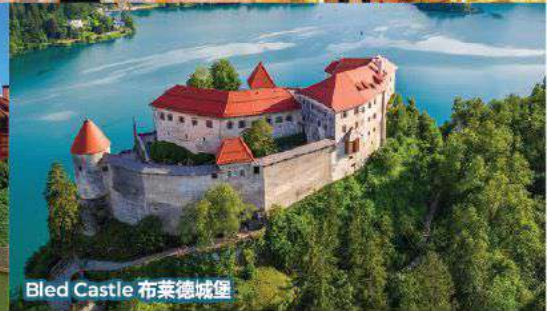

DAY 6 SPLIT - DUBROVNIK

(Breakfast / Chinese Dinner)

Today, travel to Dubrovnik, also known as Pearl of the Adriatic. Be in awe as you set eyes on Dubrovnik with its orange-hued roofs, ancient city walls, marble streets and Baroque buildings. Designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the city's landmarks such as **Rector's Palace, Clock Tower, St Blaise Church, Onofrio Fountain, Orlando's Column, Sponza Palace** and **City Walls** which will not fail to impress. After, see **Franciscan Monastery** up close, which also houses Europe's 3rd-oldest pharmacy. You may wish to join an optional cruise to sail along the Adriatic Sea, or take a ride up to Mount Srđ for breathtaking views of the Old City at your own expense.

DAY 7 DUBROVNIK - KOTOR - DUBROVNIK

(Breakfast / Lunch / Adriatic Seafood Pasta Dinner)

Today, travel to Kotor, a coastal town in Montenegro. Explore the **Old Town** and marvel at its many UNESCO World Heritage Sites including medieval churches, fortifications and **Square of the Arms**. Next, get ready to be lost for words as you stand before the mountain-rimmed **Bay of Kotor**, the deepest natural fjord-like bay in the Mediterranean Sea. The scenery around it, including the steep mountains which come almost straight down to the water edge, is spectacular.

DAY 8 DUBROVNIK - MOSTAR - SARAJEVO

(Breakfast / Bosnian Bey Soup and Cevapi Dinner)

This morning, cross the border to Bosnia and Herzegovina, continue our journey to the ancient town of Mostar. Mostar was initially developed by the Ottoman Empire and occupied by generations of multicultural residents ever since. Packed with plenty of architectural gems from different eras, ranging from pre-Ottoman, Ottoman, Mediterranean and Western European architectural elements, the city is a feast for the eyes. Walk across the old town's indisputable star, **Stari Most**, also commonly known as Old Bridge, and revel in the moment as the pale stone arch cast a sweeping reflection on the Neretva River beneath. Proceed to Sarajevo, the capital of Bosnia and Herzegovina, is a city that had risen from the ashes time and time again from its tumultuous times throughout history.

Hotel: Hotel Ibis Styles or similar

Optional Tour: Visit Blagaj Historical Village

DAY 9 SARAJEVO - KUALA LUMPUR

(Breakfast / Meals on Board)

Now, its rejuvenated historic centre is filled with spired minarets, bustling bazaars and a certain buzz about the town. Explore **Gazi Husrev-beg Mosque** and stroll down the cobbled streets of Bascarsija, founded by the Ottomans in the 15th century and you may think that you have landed in Turkey! Sarajevo is also the city that hosted the 1984 Winter Olympics. Visit **Tunnel Museum** to experience the life of the besieged during the war. If time permits, shop for traditional and handcrafted wares and try Bosnian coffee at your own expense. If time permits, of course there is always last-minute shopping before bidding farewell to Sarajevo as you transfer to the airport for your flight home.

DAY 1 吉隆坡 - 卢布尔雅那

(机上用餐)

吉隆坡机场集合，搭乘航班前往斯洛文尼亚的首都 - 萨格勒布。

DAY 2 卢布尔雅那 - 布莱德湖 - 卢布尔雅那

(机上用餐 / 晚餐)

抵达后，前往斯洛文尼亚最著名的湖泊 - 布莱德湖。踏上布莱德湖观光之旅。惊叹于令人绝妙的水晶蓝绿色湖泊，沉浸在田园诗般的环境和清新清新的空气中，许多人描述为地球上的天堂。乘坐 **pletna 游船** 前往布莱德岛，深入探索该地区的美景，**布莱德岛** 是一座风景如画的小岛，其上矗立着精致的圣母升天教堂。接下来参观**布莱德城堡**，享用丰盛的午餐，并从岩石悬崖顶上的城堡高处欣赏壮丽的景色。

DAY 3 卢布尔雅那 - 波斯托伊纳 - 萨格勒布

(早餐 / 中式晚餐)

今天，深入了解卢布尔雅那这座古老城市的魅力。您将游览巴洛克风格的**圣尼古拉斯教堂**，其双钟楼及高耸的圆顶将令您印象深刻。接着，漫步于**中央市场**里的各色迷人小商店，沿途还可以选购喜爱的伴手礼及当地产品，如苹果及蜂蜜。这市场环绕在卢布尔雅那河东岸，处于**三重桥**及**龙桥**之间，逛街的同时您也可尽享美景。您将跨过三重桥前往这座城市的主要交汇点，以斯洛文尼亚著名诗人弗朗斯普雷舍伦命名的**普列舍仁广场**。之后，继续参观斯洛文尼亚最著名的地标之一，**波斯托伊纳洞穴**。今晚，前往萨格勒布夜宿。

DAY 4 萨格勒布 - 普利特维斯 - 扎达尔

(早餐 / 海鲜配 Ozjusko Pivo 啤酒晚餐)

今天，您将穿越时光回到中世纪，漫步上城区，观赏**圣马尔谷教堂**、**石门**和古老的**罗特尔许查克塔**。接着，参观这座古老的中欧城市，上城区充满巴洛克风情，有风景如画的露天市场和绝佳的购物场所。欣赏**耶拉契奇总督广场**、**萨格勒布大教堂**等景点，并在**多拉克菜市场**和**伊利卡街**漫步。接下来，前往欧洲最令人印象深刻的国家公园之一 - **普利特维采湖国家公园**。在这个联合国教科文组织国家文化遗产公园内，您可以享受美丽的风景，这里有十六个湖泊，它们通过一系列瀑布相互连接，还有茂密的森林，栖息着鹿、熊、狼、野猪和稀有的鸟类。通过参加电动船游览，您可以从水上以不同的视角欣赏大自然的令人陶醉之美。然后前往扎达尔，这座城市位于克罗地亚的亚得里亚海中心，充满了三千年的激动人心的历史。

DAY 5 扎达尔 - 斯普利特

(早餐 / 午餐 / 达尔马提亚烤鱼晚餐)

早餐后，开始扎达尔市区游览。沿着城市的主要街道 **Kalelarga** 漫步，观赏亚得里亚海沿岸最大的**罗马广场**。接下来，惊叹于**圣多纳堂**和**扎达尔主教座堂**的宏伟设计，和聆听这座城市著名的**海风琴**。然后驱车穿过克罗地亚乡村前往克罗地亚第二大城市斯普利特。踏上城市之旅，游览最重要的景点，感受达尔马提亚斯普利特市的繁荣。当您面对**戴克里先宫**、**朱庇特神庙**和**圣多努斯教堂**时，您将重温过去的岁月。这座迷人的城市拥有引人注目的海岸线和亚得里亚海周围罗马、文艺复兴和哥特式建筑遗迹的碧绿海水，是一处值得一看的景点。

DAY 6 斯普利特 - 杜布罗夫尼克

(早餐 / 中式晚餐)

早餐后，前往被誉为“亚得里亚海之珠”的杜布罗夫尼克。您将能看到杜布罗夫尼克独有的**橙色屋顶**、**古城墙**、**大理石街道**和许多巴洛克风格的建筑物。该市被列为世界遗产，拥有众多极具代表性的地标，如**总督宫**、**钟楼**、**圣布莱斯教堂**、**大欧诺佛喷泉**、**奥兰多石柱**、**斯彭扎宫**以及**城墙**，必定能让您对这座城市留下深刻的印象。随后，前往**方济各修道院**，并且近距离观赏修道院以及挥发您的想象力想像自己住在中世纪的场景！该处也是欧洲第三大古老药房的所在地。您可以悠闲地享受接下来的剩余时间，并且乘此空档探索老城区或游览集市。除此之外，您也可以选择自费参加乘船游览活动或登上**Srd山**顶观赏杜布罗夫尼克迷人的风景。

DAY 7 杜布罗夫尼克 - 科托尔 - 杜布罗夫尼克

(早餐 / 午餐 / 亚得里亚海海鲜意面晚餐)

今日，前往位于黑山的沿海城镇 - 科托尔。科托尔以自然和文化历史区被列入世界遗产而闻名，其中著名景点包括其**老城区**的中世纪教堂和防御工事以及**武器广场**。接下来您，将前往其位于地中海最深的自然峡湾 - 科托尔湾。在这里，您能在峡湾的最边缘看到最迷人且自然的壮丽风景，尤其是周围的景色。其中，**科托尔湾**最壮观的景色来自于从陡峭山区几乎直线下降到水边的景观。

DAY 8 杜布罗夫尼克 - 莫斯塔尔 - 萨拉热窝

(早餐 / 波斯尼亚贝汤和塞瓦皮晚餐)

今早，前往波斯尼亚和黑塞哥维那，继续我们的旅程前往莫斯塔尔古镇。莫斯塔尔最初由奥斯曼帝国开发，自那时以来一直由多代多元文化的居民所占据。该古镇以拥有不同时代建筑瑰宝而闻名遐迩，其中建筑元素包括来自奥斯曼帝国时期前，奥斯曼帝国、地中海及西欧时期的元素，因此素有“视觉盛宴”之称。接着，游览莫斯塔尔古镇最为著名的**石桥**。古桥的墩台为石灰石，而且与水边悬崖边上的翼墙相连，欣赏时还可在桥下的内雷特瓦河捕捉到其倒影。然后前往波斯尼亚以及黑塞哥维那的首都 - 萨拉热窝。萨拉热窝不仅是最大的城市，它也是在历史悠久的动荡时期中复兴多次的城市。随着萨拉热窝的复兴重建，该城市也变成了发展最快的城市之一，并且在各处建设尖塔、繁华的集市，使其充满热闹的现象。

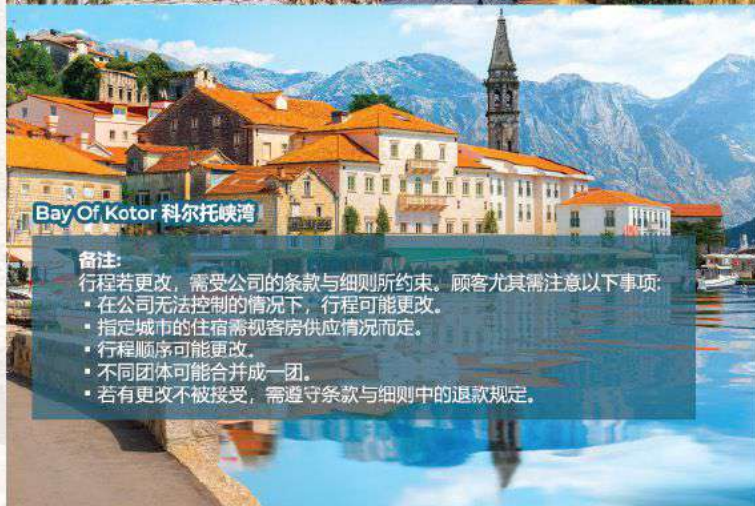
DAY 9 萨拉热窝 - 吉隆坡

今早，漫步于15世纪奥斯曼人所建的**鹅卵石大街**巴什察尔希亚，你可能会错觉自己到了土耳其！您将探索**格兹·胡格雷·贝格清真寺**。您也将参观**隧道博物馆**，体验战争期间被围困在城内的人们生活。下午，您可以自由安排行程，例如品尝波斯尼亚咖啡及购买传统手工艺品。如果时间允许，您可以做最后的购物，然后再到萨格勒布的机场搭乘航班返程。
